

## Tu voudrais te marier? - Would you like to get married? (Theme 1 - Identity & Culture)

Students will be revising family and relationships; they will be talking about friends and what makes a good friend as well as using irregular verbs in the <u>present tense</u>. Pupils will be talking about family relationships using <u>reflexive verbs in the present tense</u>. Students will also express their future intentions and what their plans are for the future in terms of relationships and consider the advantages and disadvantages of getting married.

## Home Learning:

Students are expected to complete <u>one piece of French home learning per week</u> this will be in the form of vocabulary tests to consolidate developing full sentences and short paragraphs based on the topic of learning using a range of tenses in French. Details of these tasks are on the Knowledge Organiser.
