Mon Collège – My school

In this topic students will be learning about school in French. They will learn how to discuss the subjects they study and give their opinion about them, and they will learn how to describe their school. They will reinforce their knowledge and understanding of giving opinions and how to use the present tense with all types of verbs in French. In addition, some students will learn how to say what they do at break time.

Home Learning:

Students are expected to complete <u>one piece of French home learning per fortnight</u> this will be in the form of vocabulary tests to consolidate developing full sentences and short paragraphs based on the topic of learning using a range of tenses in French. Details of these tasks are on the Knowledge Organiser.

Be able to use the present tense with -er, -re and -ir verbs.
