

Teaching and Learning Content: Who was Jesus?

Year Group: 7

Spring 1 –Term 3



Topics:

- Birth of Jesus
- Baptism
- Trinity
- Temptations of Jesus

Home Learning:

Students are expected to complete **one piece of home learning every week** as well as learning key words, facts and teachings in Knowledge Organiser **every week**.

Key Questions:

- Who was Jesus?
- Why is the Holy Trinity important to Christians?
- What is Baptism?
- What were the temptations of Jesus in the desert?

Students will:

- To describe who Jesus was and why he was important
- To explain with examples of what the messiah means to Christians.
- To know where Jesus grew up
- To describe the accounts of Jesus' birth from the Gospels of Matthew and Luke
- To examine how significant Jesus' birth is to Christians
- To know who the three persons of the Trinity are
- To explain the importance of the Trinity.
- To understand who Jesus was tempted by and the reasons why Jesus did not give in to temptation.
- To explain whether it is impossible not to give into temptation.

Diagnosis

- End of unit assessment for each half term
- Retrieval activities from knowledge organisers like starter quizzes and true or false statements
- Mini whiteboard activities
- Keyword vocabulary tests

Therapy

- Sharing model responses (teacher/student led feedback)
- DIRT tasks
- Peer to peer support in lessons
- Specific highlighted lessons for students
 - Revision cards
 - Walking talking of exam questions and answers.
 - Mind maps

Testing

- Students will complete an assessment each half term from which they will receive feedback to continue to highlight areas of weakness into the next half term.
