

Teaching and Learning Content: Spanish
Year Group: 10
Half Term 3



De costumbre – Customs

Student will learn how to talk about customs and festivals typical in Spain in this topic. They will learn to talk about typical foods in Spain and how to use words which indicate an *increase* or *decrease*. They will also look at discussing festivals in Spain and comparing them to traditional festivals we have in England. In addition they will look at questioning and giving information about their own experiences. Students will learn how to give information about a special day they have experienced and what they felt about it in the past tense. They will practice being able to order in a restaurant, building on what they learnt in KS3 and finally talk about a music festival using phrases which use an *infinitive verb*.

Home Learning:

Students are expected to complete **one piece of Spanish home learning per week** this will be in the form of vocabulary tests to consolidate developing full sentences and short paragraphs based on the topic of learning using a range of tenses in Spanish.

Details of these tasks are on the Knowledge Organiser.

Key Questions:

- What are the main festivals which take place in Spain?
- How do they festivals in Spain compare to those in England?
- What typical foods can you talk about in Spanish? Have you tried any?
- How can you indicate if something had *increased* or *decreased*?
- How can you give information about festivals that you have experienced?
- How can you add detail with different tenses?
- How can you use both the *preterite* and *imperfect tenses* when describing your special day in the past?
- How do you order food at a restaurant in Spain? What words will you need to remember?
- What is your opinion on music festivals?

Diagnosis

- Retrieval activities from knowledge organisers through weekly testing.

Therapy

- Sharing model responses
- Using new vocabulary and grammar structures in a variety of different tasks.
- Peer and self-assessment tasks to deepen understanding of content.

Students will:

- Be able to talk typical festivals and celebrations in Spanish.
- Be able to appreciate the differences between common celebrations in Spain and England.
- Be able to discuss foods typical to Spain.
- Be able to give information about a special day in the past tense.
- Be able to use a variety of tenses together.
- Be able to order food confidently in a restaurant in Spain.
- Be able to give a detailed opinion on music festivals in Spanish.

Testing

- Students will complete an assessment in two of the four skills (Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening) to test their understanding and grasp of vocabulary and grammatical concepts.
