Teaching and Learning Content: Travel and Tourism

Year Group: 10

Autumn Term - Half Term 3



Topics:

Explore popular visitor destinations

Home Learning:

Largely research based to enable students to build upon content ahead of assessments

Key Questions:

- Where are popular visitor destinations in the UK?
- What types of tourism and tourism activities do people engage with?
- How popular are destinations with which different visitor types?
- What travel options exist to access tourist destinations?

Diagnosis

- Retrieval activities from knowledge organisers like starter quizzes
- Cold Calling
- Exit tickets

Therapy

- Sharing model responses (teacher/student led feedback)
- Live marking (Purple Pen)
- Peer to peer support in lessons and self-assessment in Green Pen

Students will:

- Understand that there are different types of destinations in the UK and across the world.
- Learn about the different features that can be found in visitor destinations and the
 extent to which specific features may contribute to a destination's popularity with
 visitors.
- Understand the meaning of tourism and the different ways tourism can be categorised.
- Learn that within each visitor type there are different compositions and age ranges to consider.
- Evaluate the suitability of popular tourist destinations for different types of visitor
- Understand the meaning of travel and the different types.
- Use their knowledge of transport operators and explore the choices of travel available to access tourist destinations, options, transport operators and/or routes for a specific journey and match for suitability to a given visitor type.

Testing

- Students will complete a practice assessment to gauge understanding ahead of official internal assessment
