Topics:

Holocaust

Home Learning:

Quiz's relating to the topic of the week, posters, research (flipped learning).

Key Questions:

- What was the Holocaust?
- Was there a history of Anti-Semitism?
- What was the Nazi racial ideology?
- What anti-Jewish measures were put into place?
- What was Aktion T4?
- What was Kindertransport?
- What was life like in the Ghettos?
- What was life like in Auschwitz and what was the 'Final solution'?
- What was liberation and the trial of Nuremberg?

Students will:

- Evaluate the US justification for the bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki.
- Understand and describe what the Holocaust was.
- Analyse the history of Anti-Semitism
- Understand Nazi racial ideology.
- Understand and evaluate what the Nazi anti-Jewish measures were.
- Understand and evaluate Kristallnacht and if it was a turning point.
- Understand and evaluate how the Nazis treated disabled people.
- Understand and analyse the British response to Jewish refugees.
- To understand what life was like in the ghettos and evaluate the treatment of Jewish people.
- Understand what life was like in Auschwitz and to analyse why the Nazis come up with the 'final solution'.
- Analyse the effects of liberation and evaluate the Nuremberg trials.

- Retrieval activities from knowledge organisers like starter quizzes
- Cold calling

Therapy

- Sharing model responses (teacher/student led feedback)
- DIRT tasks- Repair lessons
- Peer to peer support in lessons
