

Teaching and Learning Content: French
Year Group: 7
Half Term 4



Mes pasetemps – My hobbies

Students will learn how to discuss their free time activities and hobbies in this topic. They will learn how to discuss how they use technology and give information about what sports they play. They will consolidate their learning on the present tense and giving opinions to use these in more depth and with greater detail in their work. They will also practice being able to say what other people do.

Home Learning:

Students are expected to complete **one piece of French home learning per fortnight** this will be in the form of vocabulary tests or the use of a vocabulary app, to consolidate developing short sentences, building to a short paragraph with simple connectives based on the topic of learning using primarily the present tense in French.

Key Questions:

- What can you remember about forming the present tense? Can you apply this learning to new verbs?
- How do you give opinions with extended reasons?
- How can you give information about what you do on your computer and your phone?
- How do you use the phrase *jouer à* to talk about activities with technology?
- Can you remember all the forms of the verb *faire* in the present tense?
- Can you use the verb *aimer* to say what you like doing in your free time?
- Can you use the 'they' form of the present tense?
- Can you add detail to sentences to say what other people like doing?

- Retrieval activities from knowledge organisers through weekly testing.

Therapy

- Sharing model responses
- Using new vocabulary and grammar structures in a variety of different tasks.
- Peer and self-assessment tasks to deepen understanding of content.

Students will:

- Be able to say what you do on your phone and the computer.
- Be able to use the present tense accurately with new verbs.
- Be able to apply learning about the present tense to new verbs.
- Be able to say what activities you like to do in your free time.
- Be able to say what sports you play.
- Be able to use the verb *faire* in the present tense accurately.
- Be able to describe what other people do.

Testing

- Students will complete an assessment in two of the four skills (Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening) to test their understanding and grasp of vocabulary and grammatical concepts.
