

**Teaching and Learning Content: French**  
**Year Group: 9**  
**Half Term 4**



**Vacances spéciales – Special holidays**

Students will learn how to talk about their holidays in French with detail in three different tenses. They will learn how to ask questions about holidays and answer in detail. They will become confident in using the conditional tense to say what they would like to do on a future holiday and making up adventure holidays. In addition, they will learn how to talk about what items they take with them on holiday and use *reflexive verbs* to talk about daily routine while on holiday. Students will learn to describe different situations on holiday and talk about visiting tourist attractions.

**Home Learning:**

Students are expected to complete **one piece of French home learning per fortnight** this will be in the form of vocabulary tests or the use of a vocabulary **app**, to consolidate developing short sentences, building to a short paragraph with simple connectives based on the topic of learning using a variety of tenses but primarily using the conditional in French.

**Key Questions:**

- How would you describe your holidays in French?
- How do you ask questions in French?
- What verbs do you know in the conditional tense?
- Can you make up an imaginary adventure holiday?
- What items would you say you take on holiday with you?
- What is a reflexive verb?
- How do you use a reflexive verb?
- Can you use detail and connectives to describe what you did on holiday?
- How can you use the 3 main tenses to talk about holidays?
- What is an emphatic pronoun?
- Can you use emphatic pronouns to add complexity?

**Diagnosis**

- Retrieval activities from knowledge organisers through weekly testing.

**Therapy**

- Sharing model responses
- Using new vocabulary and grammar structures in a variety of different tasks.
- Peer and self-assessment tasks to deepen understanding of content.

**Students will:**

- Be able to describe your holidays in French.
- Be able to ask and answer questions about your holidays.
- Understand how to form questions.
- Be able to use the conditional tense with accuracy.
- Be able to use reflexive verbs with some accuracy.
- Be able to write in detail with a range of vocabulary and connectives to show detail and fluency.
- Be able to use all 3 tenses with some accuracy to describe your holidays.
- Be able to use emphatic pronouns.

**Testing**

- Students will complete an assessment in two of the four skills (Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening) to test their understanding and grasp of vocabulary and grammatical concepts.
