

<u>Hacia un mundo mejor – A better world (Theme 2: Local, national, international and global areas of interest)</u> Students will learn how to talk environmental and social issues that are facing the world on different levels. They will learn to discuss in detail environmental problems and the causes and effects of these problems. They will also learn how to talk about the social issues surrounding healthy living and vices facing young people. They will learn how to use the <u>subjunctive tense</u> and revise using the <u>present continuous</u> and <u>imperfect continuous</u> tenses to add high levels of complex phrases to their work. They will talk about local actions and campaigns they are involved in and will discuss the positive and negative sides to hosting a large scale sporting event.

## Home Learning:

Students are expected to complete <u>one piece of Spanish home learning per week</u> this will be in the form of vocabulary tests and a vocabulary app to consolidate developing full sentences and short paragraphs based on the topic of learning using a range of tenses in Spanish.
