Show understanding of the relationships between texts and the contexts in which they were written. Compare writers' ideas and perspectives, as well as how these are conveyed, across two or more texts. Communicate clearly, effectively and imaginatively, selecting and adapting tone, style and register for different forms, purposes and audiences. Organise information and ideas, using structural and grammatical features to support coherence and cohesion of texts.
